Did You Know:

- Scientists report wild salmon stocks crash near fish farms worldwide
- Fish farms break the natural laws that keep disease and parasites under control.
- Fish farming can be done on land to protect wild fish
- **92% of fish farms in BC are Norwegian-owned** and must relentlessly expand to meet shareholder demands
- Canada ignores global spread of the highly infectious ISA virus in Atlantic salmon eggs allowing imports to continue
- Fish farms = 4,000 jobs, \$400 million paid largely to foreign shareholders
- Wild salmon = 52,000 jobs, \$1.6 **Billion** (incl. wilderness tourism, fishing)
- The Fraser sockeye crash is a bulls-eye pattern affecting only those stocks known to migrate north past 60 fish farms
- Top Canadian officials are misinforming the public about the Fraser sockeye crash and salmon farms
- This is *exactly* how we lost one of earth's biggest human food resources, Atlantic cod and **no one was held accountable**
- Salmon farms operate in contravention of many section of the Canadian Fisheries Act
